David: Welcome to *Cool English*! Let me introduce you to the team. I'm David, the editor and this is Tina. She's the photographer. She's got some amazing photos.

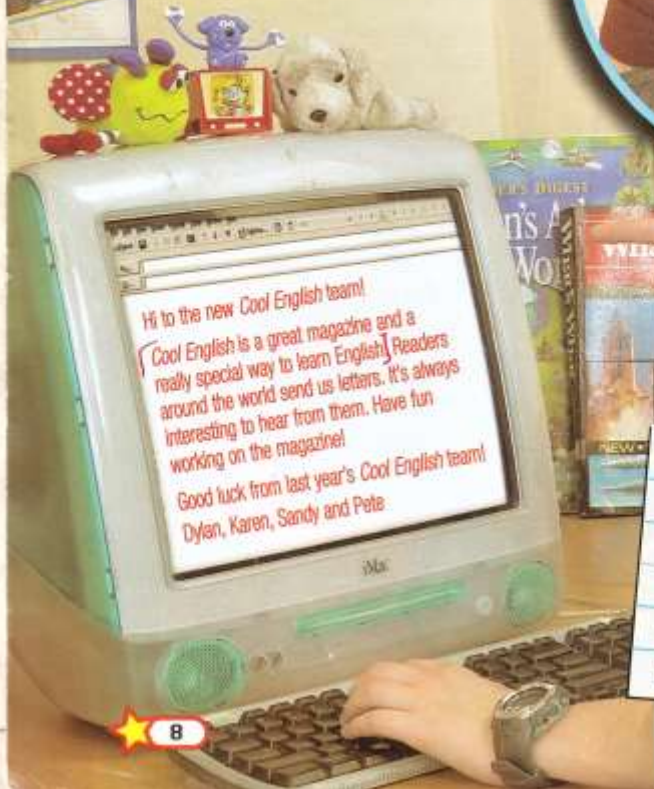
Tina: Hi Wendy! It's nice to meet you. Do you want to see my photos? I hope we can use them for the first issue.
